The Math Academy includes 3 institutes; The Pre-Algebra Institute, Algebra Institute and Geometry Institute- 8:00 a.m.-12:00 p.m. M.A. is a **FREE** college focused, six week, intensive but fun four hour a day/five days a week course that is designed to improve the students skills and attitude toward math. Each division of the Math Academy is facilitated by certified math instructors. M.A. is designed for Middle School and High School students who are having difficulties in math or are preparing to take one of the math subjects in Fall 2008.

The program also includes a college preparation component that consists of campus visits and exposure to math-based careers and opportunities in higher education.

The Summer Mentor/Teacher Internship Program- 7:00 a.m.-6:00 p.m. This is a hands-on program that is instrumental in introducing teens grades 10-12 to the world of mentoring and teaching. The program was developed to support teens whose career goals include working with children.
